European Data Protection Supervisor Makes Recommendations for the New General Data Protection Regulation

The European Data Protection Supervisor (EDPS) has recently called for pragmatism in the wording of data protection reforms. Among the EDPS' recommendations, there are proposals to simplify the planned new rules on data protection impact assessments and the reporting of data breaches to regulators and affected customers. The EDPS has highlighted the importance of providing corresponding guidance to the Regulation in order to minimise excessive detail in the Regulation itself.

European Court of Human Rights Rules that Privacy Right is More Important than Journalistic Freedom

The European Court of Human Rights (ECHR) ruled in the case of *Satakunnan Markkinaporissi and Satamedia v Republic of Finland* that a magazine who had published publicly available tax data could be prevented from doing so in order to protect the privacy rights of individuals. The ECHR ruling confirmed that there is no overall protection for journalism under data protection legislation. Equally, the importance of the public interest value of the publications and its significant role in the court's reasoning were also re-emphasised.
