

FCC Wireline Competition Bureau Announces Opening of COVID-19 Telehealth Program Application Portal

The Federal Communications Commission's (FCC) Wireline Competition Bureau (Bureau) has issued a Public Notice (Notice) announcing that the online portal for filing applications for the COVID-19 Telehealth Program opens on April 13, 2020.

Applications may be filed through a dedicated application portal, available on the COVID-19 Telehealth Program page: www.fcc.gov/covid19telehealth. The Bureau will accept applications on a rolling basis and will select participants until all COVID-19 Telehealth Program funding has been committed or the current pandemic has ended.

To assist applicants in preparing their applications, the Bureau has made available a recorded webinar presentation, accessible on the COVID-19 Telehealth Program page. The presentation assists interested parties in navigating the application portal and provides answers to frequently asked questions regarding the COVID-19 Telehealth Program's application process. The webinar will remain publicly available for viewing.
