

## Changes in Registration of EAC Declarations Starting From 1 January 2021

EMEA – 12 March 2021

On 1 January 2021, the Order of the Ministry of Economic Development of Russia, dated 31 July 2020, No. 478 “On Approval of the Procedure for Registration of Declarations of Conformity and the Procedure for the Formation and Maintenance of a Unified Register of Registered Declarations of Conformity, Provision of Information Contained in the Specified Register” (the Order) came into force.

The Order changes the procedure of registration of EAC Declarations in Russia.

The main change is that certification agencies will no longer be able to register EAC Declarations. All documents for registration of EAC Declarations should be filed by the General Director of an applicant by using his/her electronic signature via a special web service of FGIS [RusAccreditation](#).

Filing an application for registration of EAC Declaration with the RusAccreditation in person or via post is not allowed.

It is worth noting that the following procedures and rules will remain the same:

- Requirements for an applicant
- Rules and procedures of taking samples for testing and importing these samples into the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU)
- Procedure of testing of samples in accredited laboratories
- Responsibility for violation of registration of EAC Declarations

Normally, the term for registering EAC Declarations with RusAccreditation is up to three working days.

However, there are several exceptions where the registration of EAC Declarations is allowed only by the accredited certification agencies, i.e. the products that are included in the following technical regulations:

- TR CU 001/2011 “Safety of railway rolling stock”
- TR CU 002/2011 “Safety of high-speed railway transport”
- TR CU 003/2011 “Safety of railway transport infrastructure”
- TR CU 006/2011 “On the safety of pyrotechnic products”

Please note that the changes will come into force exclusively in the Russian Federation.

At the level of the EAEU, the decisions of the EEC Board No. 41 of 20 March 2018 and No. 293 of 25 December 2012, which determine the procedure for registering EAC Declarations, will still be in force. However, we cannot exclude that some amendments will be made to these decisions.
