

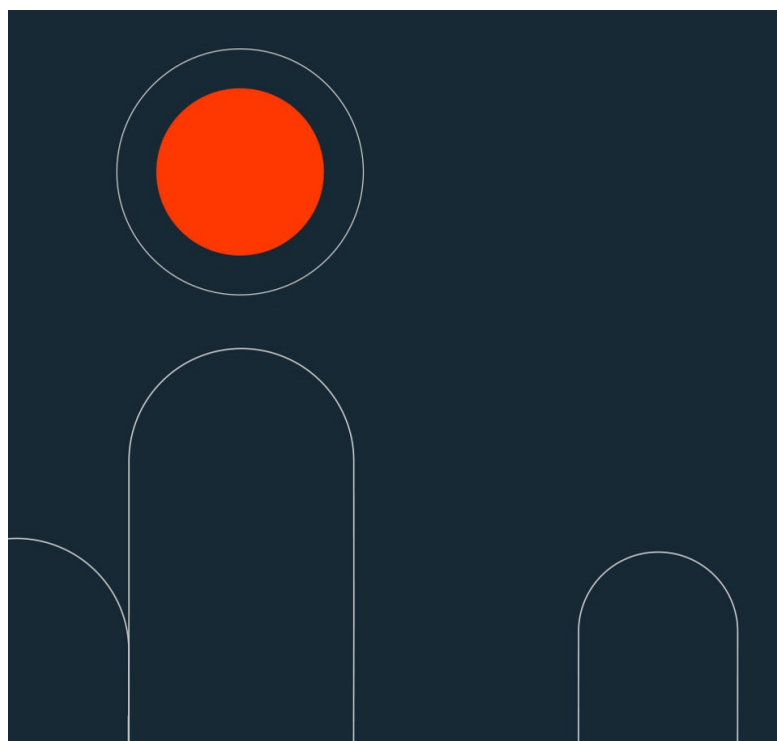

Before joining the Department of Commerce, Trevor served as advisor to the president of the World Bank Group, providing strategic analysis and policy guidance on sovereign finance, development policy, debt sustainability, debt transparency, institutional reform and international economic affairs.

Earlier in his career, Trevor served as special advisor for international affairs and assistant executive secretary at the US Department of the Treasury, where he advised senior leadership on international economic policy, investment security, trade enforcement, economic sanctions and global financial matters. His work included supporting the implementation of key trade and investment security

measures and US engagement in major multilateral economic forums. He also worked in management consulting, advising corporate and government clients on fiscal management, regulatory compliance and financial risk.
